Fundraising News

Since receiving £350 from John Lewis stores, which went towards the Pantomime trip, there is no news of further fundraising. However, I will get on the case and hope to be as lucky as last year. In the meantime I would like to tell you a little about why fundraising is so important to FLAG.

FLAG's aim is to ensure that events are good value for money. For example we just charged £10.00 for our coach trip to Woburn Abbey Safari Park. When you think of it that is incredible value for money, when you consider it included hiring a coach for £400 and entry to the park. It was only possible because we received funding from a charitable trust.

Most of our funding comes from writing to charitable organisations, but this has not always been the case. In the past, members have run car boot sales, coffee mornings etc.

Remember, FLAG gets NO funding from social services or the local authority, and relies solely on ourselves to cover our administration costs and keep events affordable. If you could help by running a fundraising event, or suggesting fundraising ideas, we would like to hear from you.
