Hampton Court Palace. 12th April 2018.

It took us about two hours to get from Bedford to **Hampton Court Palace**. The coach parked at a nearby railway station and we walked across a bridge over the Thames to get the 200 yards to the entrance.

Hampton Court is a royal palace in the borough of Richmond upon Thames. Building of the palace began in 1515 for Cardinal Thomas Wolsey, a favourite of King Henry VIII. In 1529, as Wolsey fell from favour, the Cardinal gifted the palace to the King to check his disgrace; Henry VIII later enlarged it. Along with St James's Palace, it is one of only two surviving palaces out of the many owned by King Henry VIII.


