

# St Pauls' Church Bedford - Christmas Tree Festival 2018 This year's theme - CHRISTMAS AROUND THE WORLD

This is FLAG's 5th year decorating a Christmas Tree for the Festival. As the theme this year was "Christmas around the World," it was decided that we should make Baubles and add flag's from all countries around the world to them. Over 4 FLAG Drop-ins the baubles were made. Firstly, members painted some polystyrene balls of four different sizes with two coats of paint, leaving them to dry after each coat.









Secondly, members painted the Baubles with a sparkly varnish called Mod Podge that paints on white but dries clear. Ribbons were then added by glue and pins and finally a different country's flag was added to each bauble.


